### Indiana State Head Coach Rick Heller opening statement:

"I was real happy with our hitters today. I thought we came out and had good focus for pretty much all the at-bats all day long. We did a good job laying off sliders down. We put pressure on them all day long and Jason Van Skike gave us a decent start. I mean, you never like to give up runs after you score runs and unfortunately we did that in the third.
