## Wichita State Head Coach Gene Stephenson

"It was a real tough job today. Evansville is a tough team and we knew that. Kai Tuomi is a tough player, we knew that after seeing him in Wichita. I think finally we were able to scrape enough runs. I just want to say we had some great at bats at critical times. Andy Dirks had several of them and Matt Brown made some great catches. Anthony Capra was lights out again."

"We hung with them for seven innings. But lost the game in the top of the eighth. We couldn't get them out. Pretty disappointing end for our 13 seniors."
