GATEWAY FOOTBALL ANNOUNCES 1993 ALL-CONFERENCE SQUAD

ST LOUIS -- Gateway champion Northern Iowa dominates the league's 1993 all-conference team, as voted by league coaches, sports information directors and a media panel and announced by the league today. Northern Iowa swept the individual honors as QB Kurt Warner and LB Andre Allen earned Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year awards, respectively. Coach Terry Allen was named Gateway Conference "Bruce Craddock" Coach of the Year for the third straight season.

Warner helped the Panthers to a 8-3 mark and fourth straight league title. He led the league in total offense with 215.6 yards per game and in passing efficiency, with a pass rating of 146.8. He is the first UNI signal-caller to win league Offensive Player of the Year honors since former Panther Mike Smith did it in 1985, the league's first year. Smith is now a quarterback coach for UNI.

Andre Allen led the Panther defense, which was ranked ninth in the nation this season, with 105 tackles, including 58 solo stops. In addition, he had seven sacks, five forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries, two pass deflections and two interceptions. A UNI linebacker has been Defensive Player of the Year three straight seasons. (William Freeney won in 1991 and in 1992.)

Terry Allen is the first coach to win Gateway coach of the year honors three times. He has a 47-14 career mark with Northern Iowa and has never lost to the same team twice in his five-year career at UNI. He is the second UNI coach to win the honor; Darrell Mudra was league coach of the year in 1985 and co-coach of the year in 1987.

Northern Iowa's Tim Mosley also posted a first for the league. He is the first player to win first-team all-league honors at two positions, as he was named to the First Team as a wide receiver and as a punter.
