State Farm Missouri Valley Player of the Week

Darren Brooks, Southern Illinois 6-3, 205, Sr., Gd. St. Louis (Mo.) Jennings High

This week's State Farm MVC Player of the Week is Darren Brooks of Southern Illinois.

Brooks helped the Salukis capture a perfect 36-0 home record against conference competition in the past four years as SIU went 3-0 last week, including two home victories. He averaged 18.3 points per game, shooting 56.3 percent from the floor (18-of-32), which included an 8-of-17 performance from beyond the arc. He made 11-of-12 free throws.

Brooks, the reigning Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in the Missouri Valley Conference also had four steals, and averaged 3.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists.

Newcomer of the Week

Patrick O'Bryant, Bradley 7-0, 260, Fr., Ctr. Blaine (Minn.) High

This week's State Farm MVC Newcomer of the Week is Patrick O'Bryant of Bradley.

O'Bryant had a stellar week for the Braves, averaging 17.3 points per game while connecting on 77.4 percent of his shots from the field (24-of-41). He also averaged 7.3 rebounds in three contests, with 15 blocks in the three games.

He tied a school record with seven blocked shots in the regular-season finale against Drake, despite being limited to 17 minutes before fouling out.

Performances of Note

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Johnny Mathies, CU -- Mathies averaged 15.7 points in three Creighton victories last week. He connected on 6-of-9 three pointers and added seven steals and seven assists in the wins.

Pete Eggers, DU -- Eggers averaged 14.3 points and 5.3 rebounds as Drake won three games last week, extending a winning streak to a season-best four games. He had his first career double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds in the season finale at Bradley.

Lucious Wagner, UE -- Wagner shot 60 percent from the floor and averaged 21.7 points in three games last week for the Purple Aces.

Vince Greene, ILS -- Greene averaged a team-best 15.7 points as the Redbirds were 0-3 last week. He also had a team-high 12 assists in the three contests.

David Moss, INS -- Moss averaged team highs of 14.3 points and 6.7 rebounds, while connecting on 41.5 percent of his shots in three games for the Sycamores last week.

Ben Jacobson, UNI -- Jacobson was phenomenal again this past week, helping the Panthers to a 2-1 week, which included a come-from-behind victory at Wichita State in the regular-season finale. His buzzer-beating three-pointer from the corner gave UNI a 67-66 win at WSU. For the week, Jacobson averaged 18.3 points per game and 4.3 rebounds.

Deke Thompson, SMS -- Thompson averaged 11.3 points and was deadly from the three-point arc last week, connecting on 7-of-11 treys as the Bears went 2-1.

Paul Miller, WSU -- Miller was the top Shocker scorer and rebounder in three games last week, averaging 14.0 points and 6.7 boards.

Happy Birthday

The 2005 State Farm MVC Tournament is the 29th edition of the league postseason event. It marks the 15th year the tournament is in St. Louis. The first tourney was in 1977, as SIU beat West Texas State in Wichita, Kan.

Salukis: No. 1 in MVC

Southern Illinois has claimed the top seed for the 2005 State Farm MVC Tournament. It marks the fourth-straight season that SIU has been the No. 1 seed. The Salukis are the first team to be the tournament No. 1 seed for as many as three-straight seasons.

Panthers Seek 2 in a Row

In league history, only Southern Illinois (1993-94-95) has won three-straight conference tourneys. Only four teams have won back-to-back conference tournament titles. UNI won last year's tournament with a double overtime victory over SMS in the title game:

Valley Champions = NCAA

Counting Southern Illinois in 2003-04, 11-straight MVC regular-season champions have reached the NCAA tournament. Illinois State (1992-93) was the last to win the league's regular-season crown and not make it.

How Seed It Is

When No. 5 seed SMS knocked off top-seeded Southern Illinois in 2004, it marked the sixth-straight season the top-seeded MVC tournament team had not won the league's postseason tourney. The last No. 1 seed to win the league tournament was Illinois State in 1998.

Southern Illinois has received three-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, and all of them have been at-large selections. SIU is the first school in Valley history to earn three at-large NCAA bids in succession.

SIU Takes Fourth Straight

Rank & File

For the third-straight year, the Valley tournament will feature a top-25 team, as Southern Illinois climbed into the USA Today/ESPN Coaches rankings of Feb. 28. SIU is No. 25. SIU was ranked in the 2004 tournament, while Creighton entered the 2003 tournament as a member of the Top 25.

Road Less Traveled

On Monday, Feb. 28, 2005, the league went a perfect 5-0 on the road. That marks the second-straight year in which the league went 5-0 in road play on the same day. Prior to Jan. 28, 2004, the last time the league went 5-0 on the road on the same day was on Feb. 13, 1982. It is believed those are the only three 5-0 road days in the 98-year history of the conference.

20-Game Winners

Including this year, the league has had a minimum of two 20-game winners in each of the past seven seasons. In 2003-04, the league had four twenty-game winners (*Southern Illinois, Creighton, UNI, Wichita State*), tying an all-time record for 20-game winners. That mark (4) had previously been reached twice (1994-95, 1999-00) in league history.

CU's 20-Win Streak at 7

In 2005, Creighton reached the 20-win plateau for the seventh-consecutive season. In the 98-year history of the Missouri Valley Conference, only three teams had done this previously in six-straight years, including Cincinnati (1957-58 to 1962-63), Bradley (1956-57 to 1961-62) and Oklahoma A&M (1943-44 to 1948-49). Creighton is the first to win 20 games in seven-straight years.

In each of the other four seasons the Panthers claimed 20 or more wins, UNI advanced to the NCAA tournament -- 1963 and 1979 (Division II), and 1990 and 2004 (Division I).

Southern Illinois' Darren Brooks earned second-team all-District 11 honors, as selected by the NABC (National Association of Basketball Coaches) on Feb. 18. He's the only Valley student-athlete to receive all-district honors.

Shooting Range

Creighton set a league record by going 16-of-19 (.842) in the second half at Wichita State on Feb. 16. The Bluejays then set a league standard by making 20 three-pointers (on 30 attempts) in their victory against Chattanooga on Feb. 19.

And SMS won its own Price Cutter Classic with wins against Youngstown State and Arkansas-Little Rock.

UNI (131 blocks) and Bradley (133) are probably both going to finish in the league's top ten for single-season blocks. Creighton holds the league record for blocks in a season, with 193 during the 1984-85 season. Bradley's 133 is now No. 10, while Tulsa's 132 blocks in 1983-84 is 11th.

Sommerville Sweep?

Junior Marcellus Sommerville of Bradley enters the tournament No. 3 in league scoring and No. 3 in rebounding. BU .. New Kids on the Block

With an active roster that features seven newcomers and five second-year players, Bradley's 13 available players for the MVC Tournament have combined to play 79 career postseason minutes. Fourth-year junior Brandyn Heemskerck (two games in 2002) is the only Brave that has played in more than one MVC Tournament game.

BU .. Braves in 26 of 28

Bradley is making its 26th appearance in the State Farm MVC Tournament. The Braves own a 23-23 all-time tournament record, winning the championship in 1980 at Robertson Field House and 1988 at Carver Arena. The Braves own a 10-11 all-time tournament record in the building now known as Savvis Center in St. Louis.

BU .. Friday History

Bradley will be playing on Friday night for the fourth time since the Valley began bringing all 10 teams to St. Louis. The Braves are 2-1 in the first-round games, but most recently dropped a 76-56 decision to arch rival Illinois State as the seventh seed last season. Bradley is 2-0 in Friday night first-round games (*last year's game vs. Illinois State was in the afternoon*).

Rookie Coaches

Counting Chris Lowery this season, 17 coaches have won 20 or more games in their first Valley season, while 17 have won the league regular-season title in their first MVC campaign. In 2003-04, Matt Painter of SIU did both.

Prior to Painter, the most-recent MVC rookie mentor to win 20 games was Barry Hinson of SMS, in 2000. Bill Hodges of Indiana State (1979) was the last rookie to win the Valley's regular-season crown.

CU .. Tournament Success

Creighton owns four league tournament titles in the last six years. On a national basis, the only schools that can claim this are Duke (5), Gonzaga (5), Kentucky (4), Creighton (4) and Winthrop (4).

CU .. Most Titles

Creighton owns eight MVC Tournament titles, twice as many as any other school. CU's .651 winning percentage in league tourney games is also the best of any team.

CU .. Arch Greatness

Creighton owns an 8-1 record in nine previous appearances in the MVC Tournament championship game. The Bluejays have won their last six appearances in the title game, including a 5-0 record in St. Louis and a 4-0 record under Dana Altman.

DU .. Remember Me?

Drake's Lynrick Rogers owns the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament record for most points scored in a game played in the Savvis Center with 38 against Wichita State in the first round of the 1997 MVC Tournament.

DU .. Looking for a First

Seniors David Bancroft, Pete Eggers and Lonnie Randolph hope to close out their collegiate careers by winning a game in the MVC Tournament. Drake has not won a tourney game since earning a 58-57 victory in a play-in round of 2000. Two of Drake's last three setbacks in the MVC Tournament have been one-point setbacks to Illinois State in 2002 (64-63 quarterfinals) and in 2003 (63-62 play-in round).

DU .. Expect a Close One

Expect another close game when Drake faces Evansville in the play-in round Friday. Drake earned a 76-72 overtime victory at Evansville on Feb. 5 and then closed out the home season, rallying for an 83-81 victory last Saturday in Des Moines.

UE .. Tourney History

This will be Evansville's 11th MVC Tournament. Drake is the only school that UE has not played. The Aces have played twice against SMS, Bradley, Southern Illinois and UNI, and once against Tulsa, Wichita State, Illinois State, Indiana State and Creighton.

UE .. Aces Snap Drought

Evansville broke a four-year drought by winning an MVC Tournament game in 2004, 63-59 over Indiana State behind the 17 points and 11 rebounds of Matt Webster. UE's best finish came in 1999, when the No. 1-seeded Aces beat Wichita State and Bradley before losing to Creighton in the title game.

UE .. More of Gore

Reserve guard Drew Gore is the only Evansville player who has seen action in the MVC Tournament each of the past three years. Sophomore Matt Webster and senior Andre Burton are the tourney scoring leaders among active UE players, with 24 points each. Webster scored all 24 of his points last season. Burton scored one as a sophomore in 2003, and 23 in the two games last season.

ILS .. Quarters Anyone?

Since joining the Missouri Valley Conference, the Redbirds own a 16-5 (.762) record in quarterfinal match-ups. The 16 ISU wins are the most quarterfinal victories by any league member since 1982 when Illinois State joined the conference.

ILS .. Showing Some Savvy

The Valley is in its 15th season in St. Louis, including the past 10 years at Savvis Center. Three teams, including the Redbirds, have had the most success in the previous 10 years at Savvis. Illinois State, Creighton and SMS have all collected 13 tournament victories in Savvis to lead the conference in win totals at the facility.

St. Louis & NCAA Basketball

Including the 2004 St. Louis Regional and 2005 Final Four, the city of St. Louis is in the midst of a stretch where it will host seven NCAA basketball championship events (either men or women) in a 13-year span (1993-2005). The Valley either has or will serve as the host institution to all seven NCAA basketball championship events.

ILS .. Catch Me if You Can

Illinois State has had a history of success at the State Farm MVC Tournament. The first league tournament was held in 1977, and the Redbirds joined the league in 1982. Despite giving other conference members a five-year head start, the Redbirds' 30 tournament wins is the most in the event history.

INS .. Tournament Talk

Indiana State owns an all-time record of 13-22 (.371) in the MVC Tournament. The Sycamores captured the Tournament Championship in 1979 and 2001. The Sycamores have failed to advance in the tournament two out of the last three years.

INS .. Waltman at MVC

Sycamore head coach Royce Waltman has guided the Trees to a record of 5-6 in the MVC Tournament. ISU's last win in the tournament was a 61-60 win over UNI in 2003.

INS .. Shades of Gray

Indiana State's David Moss and Eric Gray are the team's only active players to have scored in double figures in the MVC Tournament. In three MVC Tournament games, Moss has scored a combined 22 points, including a 12-point effort against UNI in 2003. Gray scored 11 points last season against Evansville, his only appearance in the MVC Tournament.

UNI .. Back-To-Back, Jack?

The Panthers captured their first-ever Missouri Valley Conference tournament championship last year, with a 79-74 double-overtime win over SMS in the championship game. They also reached the title game in 1994, losing to Southern Illinois.

UNI .. Mr. ESPN

Ben Jacobson certainly likes it when the ESPN cameras televise the Panthers. In three games on ESPN -- the 2004 State Farm MVC Championship, Feb. 5, 2005 at Creighton and Feb. 16, 2005, against Western Michigan -- the 6-3 junior guard has scored 26, 31 and 29 points, respectively. Jacobson was named the 2004 MVC tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

UNI .. Outstanding Panthers

Ben Jacobson (2004) was the second UNI player to earn Most Outstanding Player honors. Cam Johnson earned the award in 1994, as he led the Panthers to the MVC title game. Johnson is the only player in MVC history to win MOP honors from a team that did not win the championship.

SIU .. Crazy Eight

Darren Brooks has played in eight MVC Tournament games in his career and scored in double figures in all eight of those games. His career average at the Valley tournament is 13.1 ppg on 52.1 percent shooting (40-of-78 FGs). His record in the eight games is 5-3.

SIU .. In Search of a Crown

As successful as Chris Lowery's predecessors were (Bruce Weber was 103-54 in five seasons and Matt Painter was 25-5 in one season), they were 0-for-6 in terms of winning conference tournaments. The last Saluki head coach to win the MVC Tournament was Rich Herrin, who won three in a row from 1993-95.

SIU .. Record Win Total

Southern Illinois enters the league tournament with 25 regular-season wins. That's the most in school history. The 1990 and 2002 squads both entered the Valley tournament with 24.

SMS .. Meet You in St. Louis

SMS is one of only two teams (Illinois State is the other) to have played in the MVC tourney each of the 15 years the event has been in St. Louis. SMS has reached the tourney finals six of the Bears' 14 years in the MVC, but has won the event just once (1992). The Bears got to the finals twice in two years under head coach Charlie Spoonhour, reached the finals twice in four years under Steve Alford and have gotten to the finals twice in their first five years under Barry Hinson.

SMS .. Winning Ways

SMS enters the tourney having assured itself of its fourth winning year in a row and fifth in six seasons under Barry Hinson. SMS has now had 20 winning seasons (and one .500 year) in 24 years in Division I. The Bears are 27th among all Division I programs in total wins, and trail only Bradley on that list among current MVC members.

SMS .. Tourney Success

In 14 previous MVC tournaments, SMS has gotten to the semifinals 11 times in addition to six trips to the finals. The Bears joined the league in 1991, the same year the MVC meet moved to St. Louis. The Bears' 19-13 mark in the MVC tourney coupled with a 9-4 Mid-Continent Conference tourney mark gives the Bears a 28-17 record in Division I league tourney play.

WSU .. Turgeon's Success

Last year, Mark Turgeon led the Shockers to a 21-11 mark and NIT berth. The 2003-04 season marked the fourth-straight year in which the Shockers have shown improvement in the win column, going from 9, 15, 18, to 21 wins in Turgeon's first four seasons. With a successful post season, WSU could show improvement in five-straight seasons, a first for any coach at WSU.

WSU .. Tourney Tales

Wichita State has two first-round wins in the MVC Tournament in the past two seasons, but the Shockers have not reached the finals since winning the title (in three games) in 1987. WSU has an all-time 18-23 record in previous MVC Tournaments.

WSU .. Tourney Experience

Wichita State's Randy Burns has averaged 13.8 points in five previous tournament games -- that figure ranks sixth among active Valley players. Senior Jamar Howard also ranks sixth among active Valley players with a 5.4 rebound average in five previous MVC tournament contests.

MVC is No. 8 in RPI, 3 Teams in Top 43

A Dozen, Cousin

Since 1994, the Valley has posted four first-round NCAA Tournament victories as a No. 12 seed, or worse. No other conference has had similar first-round NCAA success. In fact, only six leagues since 1994 have had more than one win by a team seeded 12 or worse: **Valley (4)**, Mid-American (2), Big XII (2), Colonial (2), Western Athletic (2), and Metro Atlantic (2). The Valley's four 12th-seeded teams to win first-round games include Tulsa (12 - 1994), SMS (12 - 1999), Indiana State (13 - 2001), Creighton (12 - 2002).

Upset Special

Since 1979, the league has had teams seeded No. 9 or worse 30 times. Those teams have combined for 12 tourney victories, and three Sweet 16 appearances (Tulsa, 1994) (SMS, 1999) (Southern Illinois, 2002).

NCAA Upset Wins

Since 1994, the Missouri Valley Conference has posted seven NCAA Tournament first-round wins as a lower-seeded team. Only the Big East (8) and Mid-American Conference (8) have more first-round NCAA 'upset' victories.
