Lowery MVC Tournament history

Chris Lowery is the only person to have won an MVC Tournament as both a player (1992, 1993) and a head coach (2006). Here's his coaching history:

Mamadou Seck all-around leader

Honorable mention All-Conference F Mamadou Seck (6-7, 220, Sr.) leads the team in scoring (13.3 ppg), rebounding (7.8 rpg), and assists (2.6 apg). He will become just the second player at SIU to accomplish the feat (Darren Brooks did so in 2004, 2005). The Senegal native has nine double-doubles on the season, giving him 16 in his 62-game career at Southern. He has led the team in either scoring or rebounding in 24 of 30 games.

Dantiel Daniels on All-Freshman team

F Dantiel Daniels (6-6, 225, Fr.) became the fourth player coached by Lowery to be named to the All-Freshman

team. The others were Bryan Mullins (2006), Kevin Dillard (2009) and Gene Teague (2010).

Daniels leads the MVC in blocked shots at 1.7 bpg and currently is second in school history in blocked shots by a freshman. He has 45 and trails only Tony Harvey (70 in 1989). He is also a threat to score, posting a career-high 22 points against No. 14-ranked Xavier on Dec. 25. He ranks fifth in the league in field goal percentage (.568).

Last meeting vs. Indiana State

On Feb. 11, Indiana State set two NCAA records against the Salukis when they made 12-of-12 3-point field goals. It was the best percentage in a game with at least 10 makes, topping Ohio State's 14-of-15 performance (93.3 percent) on March 6, 2011, vs. Wisconsin. The 12-straight makes was also a record.

Front-court dominated team

SIU is a front-court dominated team, led by Seck and Daniels. The duo shoot .513 from the field, while the rest of the squad combines to shoot .378. Seck and Daniels have accounted for 33 percent of the team's scoring and 37 percent of its rebounding.

Salukis have limited MVC Tournament experience

On SIU's active roster, only four players have experienced an MVC Tournament game. Justin Bocot leads the team with four games and 33 career points in the tourney. Kendal Brown-Surles (3 games, 27 points), Mamadou Seck (2 games, 25 points) and Diamond Taylor (2 games, 2 points) also have tournament experience.

Salukis on lineup No. 16

Head coach Chris Lowery is on his 16th different starting lineup of the season. Last Saturday versus Northern Iowa, the lineup featured forwards Mamadou Seck and Dantiel Daniels, plus guards Jeff Early, Kendal Brown-Surles and Justin Bocot. Eleven-different players have made starts, and Seck is the only player to start every game. Louisiana Tech leads the nation with 19 different lineups on the season, while SIU is fifth.

20-loss seasons

In the 99-year history of the program, SIU has had three 20-loss seasons (1981, 1986 and 2012). The 1981 and 1986 teams each lost 20 games, while the 2012 team has lost 22 heading into the MVC Tournament.

Series vs. Indiana State

The Salukis hold a 78-41 advantage in the all-time series. From 2000 to 2009, the Salukis were 18-5 against the Sycamores. Since 2010, they are 1-4, with the only win a 73-67 victory in Carbondale on Jan. 13.

KBS has 24 assists and four turnovers in last seven games

G Kendal Brown-Surles (5-10, 170, Jr.) has 24 assists and four turnovers in the last seven games. He is second on the team in 3-point shooting (36-of-117, .308). KBS missed the first six games of the season to focus on academics. In his first game back on Dec. 17, the second-cousin of Chris Lowery had career-highs in points (19) and steals (5) at Northern Illinois.

Saluki opponents on fire from 3-point

SIU's last five opponents have combined to make 47-of-74 shots (.635) from 3-point range. On Feb. 11, Indiana State made 12-of-12. On Feb. 14, Creighton made 12-of-14 shots from three. The Bluejays also set a Missouri Valley Conference record by making 77.5 percent of their field goals.

Jeff Early returns to starting lineup

Jeff Early (6-3, 185, Jr.) is the team's second-leading scorer and has scored in double figures in eight of the last 14 games, including a career-high 18 points at Drake on Feb. 22. He made the game-winning free throw with 2.6 seconds remaining to beat Evansville on Feb. 4.

Early and Saluki G T.J. Lindsay were teammates at Monroe College (N.Y.) last year, leading the club to a 31-5 record and the JUCO Final Four. Early was an All-American and the Region XV Player of the Year. Lindsay was the team's point guard.

T.J. Lindsay is top 3-point marksman

The team's top 3-point shooter is G T.J. Lindsay (6-3, 175, Jr.) who has converted 38-of-107 (.358) on the season. He started the first two games of the year at point guard, but then switched to the 2-guard spot. Against Illinois State on Jan. 1, he was 6-of-7 on 3-point tries.

Double-figure scoring guards

Last season, the Salukis did not have a guard average double figures in scoring. That had not happened at SIU since the 1980-81 season, when center Rod Camp led the team with 15.2 points per game and no other player averaged in double figures.

At home versus MVC

During six seasons from 2001-02 through the 2007-08 campaign, SIU posted a 62-2 record against MVC opponents on its home court. The last four seasons, however, the Salukis are 15-21 in league home games.

Three freshmen combine to make 43 starts

Three true freshmen have combined to make 43 starts for the Salukis so far this season: Dantiel Daniels (24), Treg Setty (10) and Josh Swan (9). The Salukis have eight players in their first year of Division I basketball (five freshmen and three JUCO transfers).

Josh Swan, Davante Drinkard sidelined with foot injuries

True freshman G Josh Swan (6-2, 180, Fr.) has missed the last nine games with a foot injury. He set a career-high of 15 points on Jan. 1 when he made 6-of-8 shots versus Illinois State. He has started nine games this season, including four starts at point guard, a position he had never played before.

F Davante Drinkard (6-9, 225, So.) has also missed the last nine games with a foot injury. In the preseason, Coach Lowery indicated Drinkard would redshirt and focus on academics. After a strong fall semester in the classroom, Drinkard returned to the team on Dec. 17 at Northern Illinois. He had a career-high 12 points at Bradley on Jan. 4, and has scored 15 points since that game.

Salukis struggling from the free throw line

SIU made just 59.5 percent of its free throw attempts during conference games. Mamadou Seck was the team's top free throw shooter in MVC games at 79.5 percent. His teammates combined to make 54 percent.

Treg Setty sets career-high versus Illinois State

Treg Setty (6-9, 200, Fr.) scored a career-high 20 points against Illinois State on Jan. 1, marking the first double-figure scoring game of his career. He entered the game 0-for-18 from 3-point, but was 2-of-4 against the Redbirds. He came off the bench on Jan. 13 to score 11 first-half points in the win over Indiana State.

Holding an opponent <60

Since Chris Lowery became head coach, the Salukis have held opponents under 60 points in a game a remarkable 111 times in 260 games — 42 percent of the time. SIU held an opponent under 60 nine times last season and has done so seven times this year.

Salukis have held 14 opponents to 65 points or less

Fourteen times this season, the Salukis have held an opponent below 65 points. They did it during two streaks (first eight games of the season, and five-straight from Jan. 24 to Feb. 8), plus the Feb. 25 game against Northern Iowa.

Elusive three-game winning streak

It has been more than two years since the Salukis have had a three-game winning streak. They won four in a row from Dec. 19, 2009 to Jan. 1, 2010.

Justin Bocot earns fifth year of eligibility

Justin Bocot (6-4, 170, Sr.), who was academically ineligible as a freshman, earned his fifth year of eligibility by completing 80 percent of his degree requirements by the end of the 2011 school year.

Walk-on Kourtney Goff contributes at point guard

Walk-on point guard Kourtney Goff (6-0, 180, Jr.) has started eight games and been a steadying influence. He has 44 assists and 32 steals on the season.

Six players have combined to miss 38 games this season for Southern Illinois.

Diamond Taylor posts career high

G Diamond Taylor (6-4, 170, So.) scored a career-high 19 points on Nov. 25 against Chicago State. Taylor originally signed with Wisconsin, but transferred to SIU in the fall of 2009. He started the last nine games of last season. Taylor was a McDonald's All-America nominee in high school where he was coached by his father at Bollingbrook H.S. (Ill.). Both parents are Saluki alums.

Four-year gap in postseason honors

The last time a Saluki player was named to the All-Conference team was 2008 (Randal Falker-1st, Bryan Mullins-2nd). It is the longest period without a player on the First or Second team in school history.

Harry Whitt sparks Dawgs in Springfield

C Harry Whitt (6-11, 220, Fr.) came off the bench to score a career-high eight points on 3-of-3 shooting from the field at Missouri State on Jan. 10. He added two steals and a blocked shot.

In December, Whitt spearheaded a Saluki Basketball Toy Drive to benefit disadvantaged children during the holiday season.

2002-07 — Seven-Straight Postseason Bids

Southern Illinois advanced to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07, including two Sweet 16s (2002, 2007). They added an NIT appearance in 2008.

The 2002 Sweet 16 was a major breakthrough for the program. The team finished the season ranked No. 22 in the nation and won a school-record 28 games. Its biggest wins were against No. 22 Indiana, Texas Tech and No. 23 Georgia.

The Salukis were no underdog during their 2007 Sweet 16 run. Seeded No. 4 in the West Region, SIU beat Holy Cross and Virginia Tech before falling to top-seeded Kansas in a 61-58 heartbreaker. The team won 29 games, defeated five NCAA Tournament qualifiers and finished with its highest national ranking in school history — No. 11.

Walt Frazier — The Rest of the Story

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting

visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them. According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season.

NIT Championship in 1967

The Salukis won the NIT in 1967 behind future NBA stars Frazier and Dick Garrett. In addition to beating Marquette for the title, some of the prestigious victories of that season included an upset of No. 2 Louisville, as well as Duke at Madison Square Garden. At that time, the NIT was almost on par with the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA field that season featured 23 teams, while the NIT invited 14 teams.

Lowery versus ranked opponents

The Salukis are 4-12 versus ranked opponents during Chris Lowery's seven-plus seasons at the helm. The most recent win came on Feb. 13, 2008, versus No. 14 Drake. The most recent loss came on Jan. 15, 2012 at No. 21 Creighton.

Five at-large NCAA bids

At-large bids to the NCAA Tournament are hardly uncommon for Southern Illinois, which received four in a row from 2002-05.

Coaching Quick Facts

Lowery, age 39, was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2005, 2006 and 2007...He is the only person in Missouri Valley Conference history to win the conference tournament as both a player (1994, 1995) and coach (2006)... Saluki coaches have won the MVC Coach-of-the-Year award four times in the last eight seasons: Bruce Weber (2003), Matt Painter (2004) and Chris Lowery (2005 and 2007).

Saluki alums Lowery, Lusk square off

Saluki alums Chris Lowery and Paul Lusk squared off as opposing head coaches on Jan. 10 in Springfield, Mo., marking the first time since 1950 that two SIU alums have opposed each other. On Dec. 29, 1950, SIU's Lynn Holder lost at Murray State, coached by Saluki alum Harlan Hodges.

More Quick Facts

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis...Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities... Since moving to Division I in 1968, SIU has been to the NCAA Tournament 10 times, including Sweet 16 appearances in 1977, 2002 and 2007.
