every major selector. After the windup of tournament play, Cincy's Bob Wiesenbahn was named on a pair of All-America first teams and Hogue on a second team.

Jucker earned the vote of his fellow mentors as "Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year." The first-year pilot of the Bearcats also finished fourth in balloting for national "Coach of the Year" honors.

High as the quality of Missouri Valley basketball was in 1960-61, it should stay at the same level or climb higher in 1961-62. Cincinnati, Bradley, St. Louis, Drake and Wichita all have the potential to emerge as champion. The Bearcats have three starters—Hogue, Tom Thacker and Tony Yates—returning and several classy sophomores moving up. Bradley gets another year from the superb Walker and help from last year's frosh club.

St. Louis looks for a big season with starters Tom Kieffer, Bill Nordmann and Donnell Reid back and a highly-touted sophomore joining the varsity. Drake is really the club to watch with holdovers Jerry Foster, Marv Torrence and Billy Hahn in the starting lineup and a slick group of sophomores on hand. Wichita again has the services of tall Gene Wiley, Ernie Moore and Lanny Van Eman (for the first semester).

Missouri Valley Conference basketball was cited indirectly late this summer when Bradley Coach Chuck Orsborn lectured at an Armed Forces clinic in Europe and the 1961-62 Cincinnati quintet performed in the Philippine Islands on a State Department sponsored trip.
