POST SEASON NOTES: Willie McCarter of Drake U., Lee Winfield of North Texas St. and Bobby Smith of the University of Tulsa played in the 1st annual Aloha Classic Tournament in Honolulu, Hawaii. The tournament was sponsored by the University of Hawaii and will be an annual affair. Winfield and Smith were All Tournament First Team choices.

Joe Shosid and Allen Winters, veteran MVC Basketball Officials, refereed in the tournament. They were the only referees from the mainland.

The St. Louis University "Billikens", for the first time in their history, have won their own St. Louis University Student Conclave Sportsmanship Trophy and Plaque.

This trophy has been presented annually by the St. Louis University Student Conclave, since 1960, to the team and crowd displaying the best sportsmanship during the conference basketball season. Bradley University has won the award seven times, North Texas State and Wichita State University one time each.

The "Billikens" amassed a total of 455 points (revised rating system) for an average of 28.4 points per game. North Texas State is the runner-up with a 389 point total, for an average of 27.8 points per game.
